Monthly Report to the Madison Board of Education
January 8, 2014**

Race to the Top Transformation Team

- The team met on Thursday, December 19, 2013 for its second quarterly meeting of the year. The group analyzed data from the student monitoring survey conducted in early December. The results showed that 64% of teachers responding ask students to monitor their own progress.
- Principals will go over the results with their staff members in January and ask teachers to collaborate on ideas for helping students monitor their progress. If teachers have already implemented this practice, principals will encourage them to have students set goals for their own progress, compare their results to those goals, and adjust their work to meet or set new goals.
- The RttT Scope of Work requires two surveys to complete evaluation of the four-year project. The Transformation Team created these documents to be given near the end of the year, asking teachers to evaluate their preparation for the Ohio Teacher Evaluation System and how well the Scope of Work prepared them for Ohio's New Learning Standards and the Next Generation of Assessments.
- The next meeting is Thursday, March 6, 2014.
