1. The Superintendent recommends the Board of Education approve the stipend of \$500 each for Stacey Wampler and Michelle Barr for Skills USA Summer Camp July 10 – 14, 2017.
2. The Superintendent recommends the Board of Education approve the purchase of updated Algebra I and Geometry textbooks from Pearson Publishers at a cost of \$40,486.18 for FY 18.
