The end of the school year is quickly approaching! If your child has medication at school, please remember to pick it up in the clinic prior to the end of the day on Thursday June 1, 2017. **NO MEDICATION** can be sent home with students. This includes both prescription and over the counter medication. **All medications, including inhalers, and Epi-Pens, must be picked up!** All medication not picked up will be disposed of. If you need to make special arrangements to pick up medication, please call prior to the last day of school to make arrangements with the School Nurse.

Dressing For Warmer Weather: As the weather warms up, please remember to follow the following items from the building dress code:

Straps on tank tops should be at least two adult fingers wide.

Tanks with wide open holes under the arms are not permitted.

Racer back tanks are not permitted unless worn with a non-racer back tank underneath that is at least two adult fingers wide.

Shorts should be finger length long with arms fully extended.
